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Key Projects

San Dieguito Double Track

- Delivers 2.1 miles of double tracking
- Replacement of 100+ year old bridge
- New special events platform at Del Mar Fairgrounds







Del Mar Bluffs Stabilization

 Phase 5 designed to ensure coastal resiliency along the bluffs for next 30 years

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- Construction includes soldier piles for stability, installation of sea walls, drainage improvements and erosion control measures
- Scheduled completion 2027

Key Projects



Downtown Platform

- New COASTER station
 - Provides a single-seat ride to the Convention Center, Gaslamp and Petco Park area

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- Allows for increased capacity at Santa Fe Depot to support increased AMTRAK, COASTER and BNSF trains
- Is in the final phases of design and is anticipated to go to construction later in 2025



Zero Emission Initiatives

- Transitioning bus fleet to zero emission operation by 2040 and currently deploying:
 - 8 Battery Electric Buses
 - Shorter, more urban routes
 - 35 Hydrogen Fuel Cell Electric Buses
 - Longer, more rural routes
- Infrastructure Upgrades
 - Hydrogen Fueling Station
 - Electric Charging Facilities
- Pursuing replacement of SPRINTER
 fleet with hydrogen technology
